The private and state sectors of capitalism !

Every day we hear from many workers that the way to solve our troubles and problems is to change the management method and transfering the stocks and ownership of the institutions to the private sector ! Others, like the Haft Tappeh's workers say the opposite and advocate for the expropriation of the private property !!

The change of ownership of work centers may cause small changes in the working and living conditions of workers in a given environment, but never and nowhere , and based on no experience , has been and will not be the source of any improvement in our lives, work and livelihood .The root of the misery rules our lives lies in the existence of capitalism .Capital, private or state exempts workers from interfering with the type and amount, hours and conditions of work and it takes most of the work of the working masses out of their hands and gives rise to its source of expansion. In capitalism, the fate of labor and production is in the realm of the power and domination of capital. Workers are just like profit machines and their role is the same as the role of tools and equipment. It's under the pressure of deprivation of the right to self-determination of labor and production that the idea of capitalist immortality takes over the minds of the workers and thus the obviousness of the existence of capital is placed in the minds of the workers. As many of our fellow workers passively throughout their lives wait for the mercy of employers, the capitalist state and regimes and so on they are lost in the delusion of privatization and governmentalization of capital and replacement of employers. If one day they turn to protest out of compulsion and despair, they consider gathering in from of the ministry of labor and government institutions and the parliament with the appeal to the law of capitalism such as a fight!!. Experience has shown that not only they haven't achieved anything but they are getting poorer every day.
